

Fetlock joint

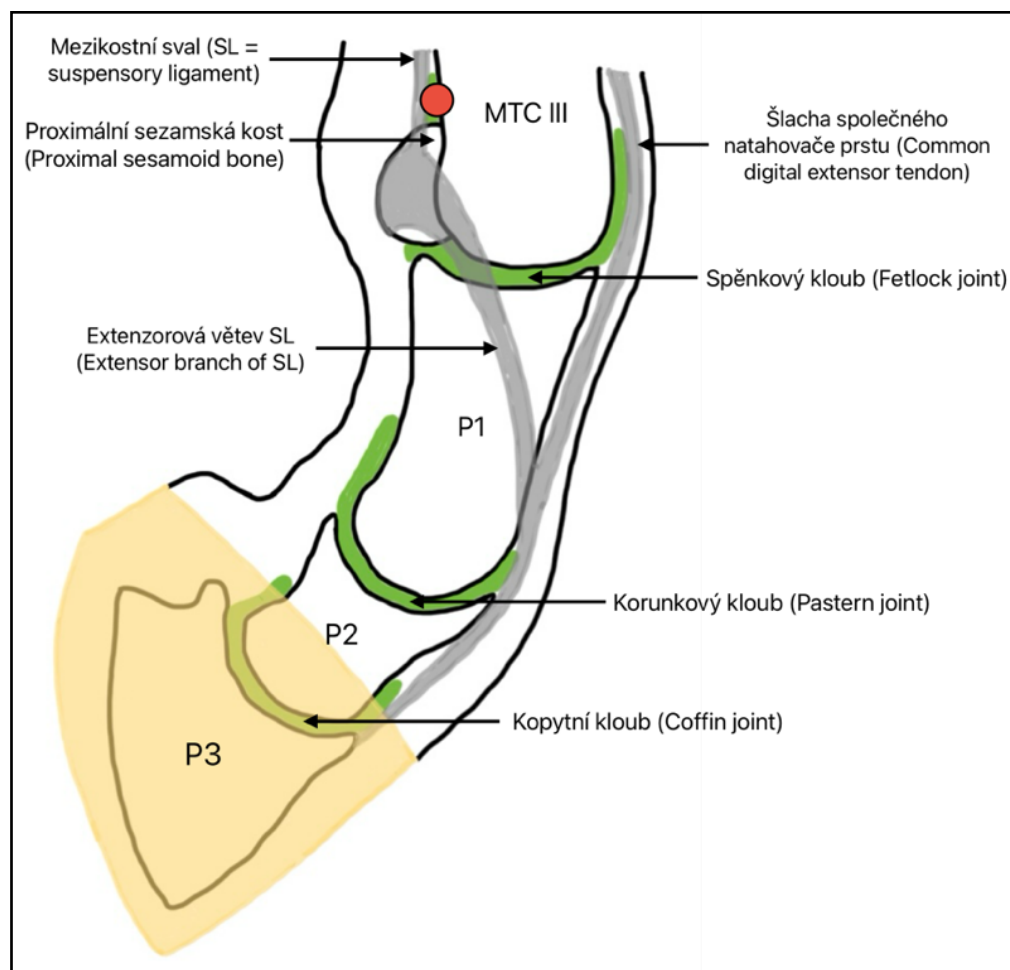
- palmar/plantar approach

Volume of local anesthetics: 8-12 ml at each site.

Limb in a flexed position.

Injection technique:

The needle is inserted into the lateral aspect of the palmar/plantar pouches of the fetlock joint. The border consist of the distal ends of the third metacarpal/matatarsal bone proximally, proximal sesamoid bone distally, the third metacarpal/metatarsal bone dorsally, the lateral branch of the suspensory ligament.





The injection site is between the distal ends of the third metacarpal/matatarsal bone proximally, proximal sesamoid bone distally, the third metacarpal/metatarsal bone dorsally, the lateral branch of the suspensory ligament.
